## PRAYER GUIDE

Saturday, May 9, 2020

Thank you for joining us in prayer for WMU Compassion Ministries—WorldCrafts, Christian Women's Job Corps (CWJC), Christian Men's Job Corps (CMJC), Pure Water, Pure Love, and Baptist Nursing Fellowship. Our ministries overlap to serve people in more than 20 countries around the globe. As this global pandemic spreads, we are hearing many stories of the ways our Father is at work. We are also learning about ways we can pray.

Here are some ways you can pray:

- Pray for all those touched by WMU Compassion Ministries to have opportunities to hear His message of eternal hope and learn about our Father's peace in the midst of their fear.
- Pray for the physical, emotional, and spiritual health of participants, their families, and their communities as they shelter in place. Social distancing is a challenge for multigenerational households who live in tight spaces and many impoverished people do not have easy access to medical care.
- Pray for WorldCrafts artisans who are dealing with many new challenges as they create and sell their products. Many are unable to work from home. Others are unable to find raw materials. Some are unable to ship their products. Demand for products has paused during this crisis. Pray for creative solutions as they face potentially difficult days ahead.
- Pray for CWJC/CMJC site coordinators and executive directors to have wisdom as they lead and make crucial decisions on how to implement classes and make connections with participants. Pray for the volunteers who give their time to teach, mentor, and encourage students through technology. Pray for participants to stay focused on their goals. Pray for participants to see provision during this time when many have lost jobs.
- Pray for communities where the primary access to clean water is through a community water source. Pray for those in these communities to stay healthy when social distancing may not be an option.
- Pray for medical personnel as they minister to their patients, especially in the midst of the pandemic. Nurses involved in Baptist Nursing Fellowship are sharing our Father's love as they provide care to their patients.
